

THREE MEN MAKE BOND IN ALLEGED CONSPIRACY CHARGE

Three men, S. E. Waterbury, Julian Drachenburg and Robert Davis, gave bond in the sum of \$1500 each, before Federal Commissioner Girand here late Saturday afternoon and were released from custody.

The men were arrested at Fluvanna some days ago and had been held
at Snyder until Friday night when
they were brought here by Deputy
U. S. Marshal Baylor Crawford. It is
said that Waterbury is a preacher
of the Apostolic faith and the other
two men were singers. They are
charged with conspiracy to oppose
the laws of the United States, it being alleged that they made anti-war
talks in the meeting at Fluvanna.

Deputy Crawford, also brought a young man here from Snyder, who is being held on a charge of failing to register. Afer being arrested the young man went before a registrar and was registered, but he is being held to await action on the original charge.
